

# REGULATIONS FOR ONLINE AND DISTANCE LEARNING CLASSES

## FALL AND SPRING SEMESTER ENROLLMENT



F-1 students may only count one online course (or equivalent of three credits) without monitoring from a school employee towards a full-course per Fall or Spring term. Students may be eligible to take more online classes to maintain their status as long as the class is physically monitored by a school employee.

- Full-time enrollment for an undergrad student is 12 credits, a minimum of 9 credits must be traditional courses, if 2 credits are online.
- Full-time enrollment for a graduate student is 6 credits, a minimum of 3 credits must be traditional courses if 3 credits are taken online.

## SUMMER AND MAY TERM ENROLLMENT

For continuing students (enrolled full-time Spring and Fall Semester), there are no restrictions regarding online enrollment in the summer. Summer term is not required for enrollment for continuing students.



## FINAL TERM OF STUDY



If only one course is needed to complete the program of study during the final semester, it cannot be online. Students can enroll in an online class during the final semester only if also enrolled in a face-to-face course. Students intending to remain in the US while finishing degree requirements and in order to be eligible in post-degree completion work opportunities must take final credits on-campus in a traditional course.
